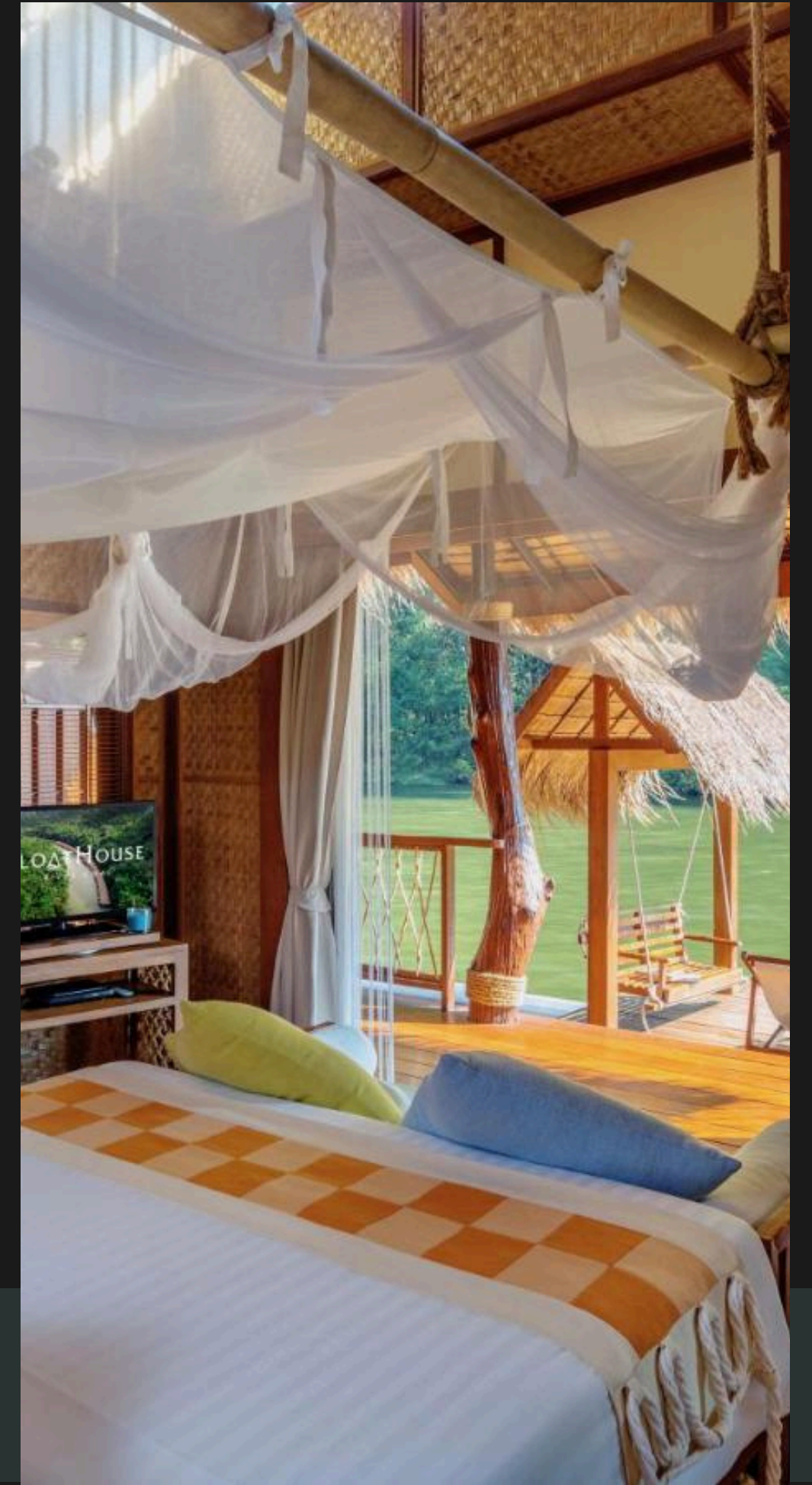


Culinary and Culture Experience
